Digium headquarters is another successful project completed by the combined efforts of Fuqua & Partners Architects and CRS Engineering & Design Consultants. This new building in Huntsville's Technology Park is another example of efficient systems design integrated with a clean design aesthetic. From the initial concepts this project was to be a statement of how technology has influenced the process and design in the working environment.

CRS incorporated many innovative systems and functionalities into a cost effective building. Both the initial costs of the systems and their operating costs over the life of the building were evaluated. CRS was an integral player in the decision process and the results are a useful and pleasing building that will perform above the standards for similar building types.

The lighting design was central to the impression of the building by emphasizing the inside/ out office environment including corner balconies. The central entry with upper level pyramidal skylight encourages the collaborative design effort desired by the owner.

This 3 story software research building also houses research and assembly areas all with individual security and environmental requirements. From the expansive lobby with its coffee bar to the high-tech meeting rooms this is no ordinary office park building, this is a creative machine.
