Here are some reminders during yard cleanup.

-  **Protective gear.** Wear gloves, goggles, ear protection and appropriate clothing. Make sure shoes or boots have good traction.
-  **Follow safety procedures.** When using tools (power/non-power) make sure guards are in place on all power tools.
-  **Disposal.** Check your local laws about burning leaves.
-  **Be cautious.** Watch for hidden objects in leaf piles (garden tools, animals, children, etc.).
-  **Practice ladder safety.** Maintain 3 points of contact. Watch for overhead lines that can electrocute you.
-  **Stay hydrated.** You can work up a sweat. Make sure you drink plenty of water.
